European Research Council (ERC) and TÜBİTAK National Contact Point for ERC in collaboration with the host institutions are organizing a series of ERC Information Days for researchers who are planning to apply 2016 ERC Calls. The events are scheduled as below:

What is the Content of the Information Day?

Presentations will provide participants with a detailed practical overview of the ERC Starting Grant, Consolidator Grant and Advanced Grant schemes. Proposal format and the key issues and tips for proposal writing, budget planning will be discussed. TÜBİTAK's newly established "ERC Principle Investigator Advancement Programme" and "Award Programme" will be introduced to the participants.

Who should attend?

The information days are aimed at researchers based in, or moving to, Turkey who are planning to submit a proposal to the ERC Starting Grant, Consolidator Grant or Advanced Grant calls.

The 2016 Starting Grant Call is open for applications until 17 November 2015. Applicants are expected to be active researchers and to have a track record of excellent research. The scheme is designed to support Principal Investigators (PIs) at the stage at which they are starting their own independent research team or programme. To be eligible for the 2016 call, the PI must be 2-7 years from their PhD on 1 January 2016, which is extendable in certain strict cases.

The 2016 Consolidator Grant Call will be open for applications during the period of 15 October 2015-2 February 2016. Applicants are expected to be active researchers and to have a track record of excellent research. The scheme is designed to support PIs at the stage at which they are consolidating their own





independent research team or programme. To be eligible for the 2016 call, the PI must be 7-12 years from their PhD on 1 January 2016, which is extendable in certain strict cases.

The 2016 Advanced Grant Call will be open for applications during the period of 24 May-1 September 2016. Applicants are expected to be active researchers and to have a track record of significant research achievements in the last 10 years. The scheme is designed to support PIs at the career stage at which they are already established research leaders with a recognized research achievements.
